

Organisational Info - Before the Festival Starts

- Please make sure you are registered for the event in advance. You will receive your personal registration link via email.
- To ensure a smooth experience, we kindly ask you to check our <u>FAQs</u> before the event, where you will find helpful preparation tips.
- When planning your travel, please consider sustainability. We encourage you to take the train, public transport, or bike whenever possible. If you are traveling by train, you can book discounted tickets here.
- If you plan to use presentation slides, please ensure that they are submitted no later than May 18, 2025 (end of day). Unfortunately, we cannot accept or include any slides submitted after this deadline.

Organisational Info - During the Festival

- Upon arrival, please proceed to the festival entrance, where you can check in and receive your lanyard and badge. This will grant you access to all event areas. There is a separate check in line for speakers, so your check in is faster. You don't need to wait in the normal queue.
- For your convenience, there will be a supervised wardrobe where you can leave coats, suitcases, or other personal belongings throughout the event.
- As a speaker, you have exclusive access to our Backstage Area on the 1st floor, where you
 can prepare for your session, relax, or network. A team member will always be present to
 assist you with any questions. Please note that we cannot take responsibility for valuables left
 unattended.

• We are thrilled to inform you that several journalists will be attending the CIRCULAR REPUBLIC FESTIVAL. In addition to our valued media partners FOCUS online earth, dfv and Start-up Insider, we are also welcoming a dedicated podcaster (Circularity.fm) and other journalists. Organisational Info - Before Your Session

- Please arrive at the event location at least 1 hour before your session to allow sufficient time
 for preparation. (You are more than welcome to attend the whole event. We will reserve some
 seats in the first row for the speakers of each session, where you can watch the program while
 you wait for your slot on stage.)
- Please be at your designated stage or room at least 15 minutes before your session starts.
 Upon arrival, please check in with the event team so that we can equip you with a microphone (headset or handheld), run through the process, and provide final instructions.
- If you experience any delays or cannot attend at the last minute, please inform our event agency ECENT at +49 89 2778 1742 as soon as possible.





Organisational info - On-Stage Information

- If you are speaking on the Green Stage, please note that your session will be live-streamed for our online audience. To ensure a high-quality video experience, we kindly ask you to avoid clothing with small patterns, stripes, or the color red, as these can be distracting on camera.
- On stage, there will be two screens in front of you. One will display your presentation, while the other will show a timer to help you keep track of your remaining speaking time.
- If you prefer to use physical notes during your session, we provide moderation cards that you can pick up in the Backstage Area before your session.

We kindly ask all speakers to be mindful of their speaking time. Since we have a full program, it is important that each session stays in schedule to ensure fairness for all participants.





Organisational Info - After Your Session

- After your session, you are invited to continue the discussion at our Speaker Corner, located in the Flash Gordon (restaurant) on the ground floor. This is a dedicated space where you can engage with the audience and answer additional questions.
- If you would like to use this option, please inform the moderator before your session so they can announce it to the audience.
- To support our sustainability efforts, we kindly ask you to return your lanyard and any unused moderation cards at the entrance when leaving the festival. This helps us reduce waste and reuse materials for future events. Your badge is made entirely of paper (including the sticker) and can therefore be disposed of in paper waste.
